We regularly receive enquiries concerning sustainability, codes of conduct and compliance. We are therefore pleased to provide the following standard information for ease of reference.

This conviction shapes both our strategic direction and our day-to-day operations. The LEHVOSS Group has been a signatory to the [UN Global Compact](#) since December 2017 and is therefore committed to its ten principles in the areas of human rights, labour standards, environmental protection and anti-corruption. We also actively support the 17 United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and participate in related collaborative initiatives.

As a company operating in the chemical industry, we also adhere to the principles of the global [Responsible Care Initiative](#), thereby continually upholding our responsibilities with regard to safety, health and the environment.

The LEHVOSS Group acts in accordance with its own [LEHVOSS Code of Conduct](#), complemented by a [Declaration of Principles on Human Rights and the Environment](#), which sets out our due diligence obligations within the supply chain. Through our [Supplier Code of Conduct](#), we define clear expectations as the foundation for responsible and successful cooperation. We expect our suppliers to comply with this code and to cascade these requirements throughout the value chain.

We report transparently on our sustainability performance and progress on our [website](#). This includes information on our greenhouse gas footprint and our participation in the EcoVadis assessment platform, where we have steadily improved our rating in recent years.
